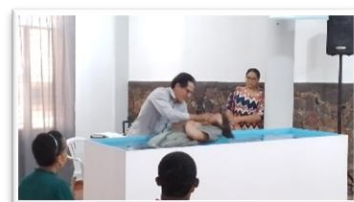

We are so thankful to see how God is working in the church in Nagua through the faithfulness of God's people and are also excited to see how God is opening doors in our region. We look forward to going back at the end of January. We are anticipating our return to the Dominican and cannot wait to see what God has in store for this next term.



Furlough Report

We spent the last two months of the year traveling and reporting to several churches in the Northeast. The Lord also gave me the opportunity to preach at my home church and at a teen camp in New Jersey during the last week of the year. Also, the Lord has continued to provide for the building fund for the church in Nagua. We are currently at 103,850, putting us at 69.93% of what we need to buy the building.
